# Biography



**Ivonne Torres**, born in Mexico City in October 1970, has always been passionate about vibrant colors and artistic expression. Growing up in a small town in Sonora, Mexico, she was surrounded by the stunning beauty of the desert landscape and the vibrant colors of its sunsets. This inspired her to pursue a career in the arts, which she began exploring at a young age.

As a child, Ivonne was fascinated by the arts and crafts of her heritage, and she spent many hours creating intricate designs and patterns using traditional techniques. She also developed a keen eye for color and composition, which served her well when she began studying interior design and visual marketing at the University of CEDIM in Monterrey, Mexico.

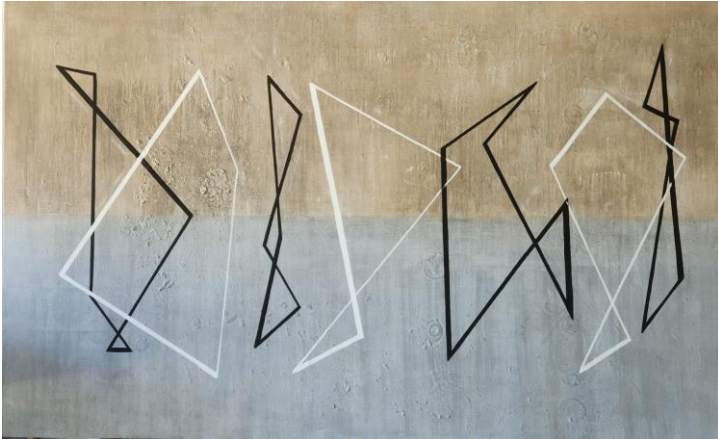
## Transition Collection

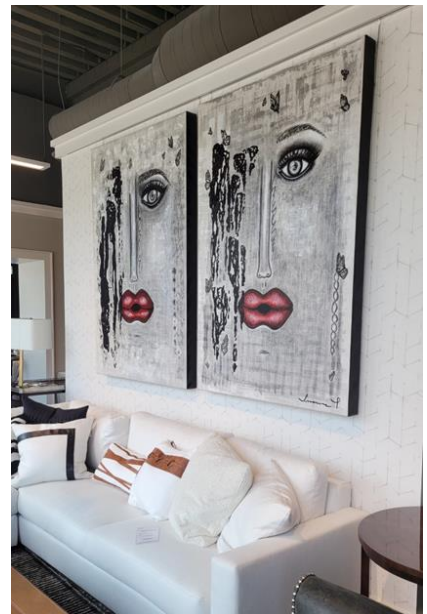

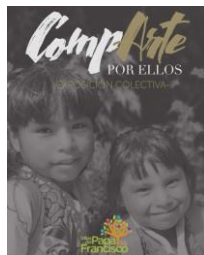

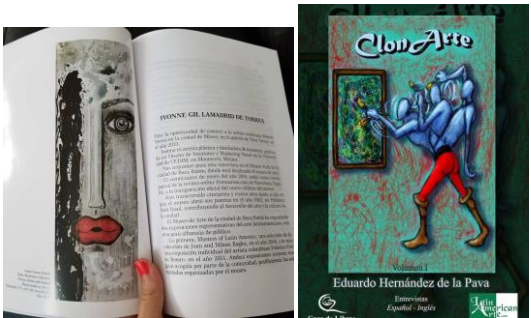
